A Heart to Serve God

My name is Bee. I was born and raised in Thung Makham Pom Village in Mae Hong Son Province, Thailand. I grew up in a Christian family with my parents, three older brothers, one older sister, and two younger brothers. Nearly everyone in our village follows Christ.

My family made a living farming in the mountains. We had very limited financial resources, and from Grade 1 through Grade 9 we often struggled to pay my school expenses. Each day I walked about four kilometers to school. Although life was difficult, God faithfully cared for me through every season.

Even as a child, I told my parents that I wanted to dedicate my life to serving God and become a good example to others. After graduating from high school, I was baptized, publicly confessed Jesus Christ as my Savior, and enrolled at Lanna Theological Center in response to God's calling.

God Began Changing Me

When I first arrived at LTC, I struggled with anxiety and lack of confidence. I was uncomfortable speaking in front of people. I spoke too quickly, making it difficult for others to understand me. I was also shy and had very little experience playing the guitar.

At times I wondered whether I would be able to complete my studies or effectively serve God's people. Yet deep in my heart I believed God was able to transform my life.

As I spent more time with Him through prayer, Bible reading, and worship, my confidence began to grow because I knew He was shaping me into the person He wanted me to become.

Growing Through God's Grace

God has taught me to be courageous—to step beyond my fears and develop the gifts He has given me. Today He uses me to lead worship each week, and He has helped me become a clearer and more confident speaker.

He has also transformed my attitude. Instead of responding to problems with fear, I now face them with hope and faith. I have learned patience, forgiveness, integrity, responsibility, and the importance of demonstrating Christ's love in everyday life.

One of my greatest challenges has been public speaking. Although criticism was difficult to hear, God used those experiences to strengthen both my faith and my character.

After graduating from LTC, I desire to use the biblical training God has given me to serve Him wholeheartedly through the local church. I want my life to honor Christ, encourage others, and faithfully proclaim the gospel wherever He leads.
